### **Excursion to Dublin**

Guided tour of Dublin, the capital and the largest city of the Republic of Ireland, the university of Dublin is the oldest university in Ireland dating from the 16<sup>th</sup> century.

Visit of Trinity College, the oldest university of Dublin founded in 1592, where the «Book of Kells» can be seen.

Discovery of Trinity College Park.

Visit of Dublinia Centre, developed by The Medieval Trust to recreate the formative period in the city's growth from the arrival of the Anglo Normans in 1170 to the closure of its monasteries by Henry VIII in 1540.

## DAY 3

### **Excursion to Wicklow Mountains**

Visit of Powerscourt gardens. A sublime blend of formal gardens, sweeping terraces, statuary and ornamental lakes.

Visit of Glendalough and the Visitors Centre, famous for its monastic site founded in the 6<sup>th</sup> century by St. Kevin, has a round tower, stone churches and numerous crosses.

Visit of the monastery in Glendalough.

## DAY 4

### **Excursion to Kilkenny and Kildare**

Visit of Kilkenny Castle and Design Centre. One of the most instantly recognised buildings in Ireland.

Visit of the National Stud and Japanese Gardens a commercial stallions for Breeders. The Japanese Gardens at Tully were created between the years 1906-1910. The Gardens, planned to symbolise the "Life of Man", are now of international renown.
